DANTE aims to deliver effective, efficient and automated data mining, analytics solutions and an integrated system to detect, retrieve, and analyse huge amounts of heterogeneous and complex multimedia and multi-language (in five languages) terrorist-related contents from both the Surface and the Deep Web, including the Dark Nets. DANTE was funded by the European Commission under Grant Agreement n°700367. It covered a period from 01/06/2016 to 28/02/2019.
